This is essentially an empirically based, theoretically sound deduction that can be made about 'subjects' from their criminal and civil activities. It also embraces comparative-case analysis (linking) and predictions of developments in behavior.

Most people have only heard of profiling connected with investigating criminal cases. While this tool is used by many law enforcement criminologists, Alexis Montgomery, our well-known Seattle private investigator, has adapted this to civil cases also.

- Profiling covers all aspects of related behavioral and social sciences relevant to criminal and civil investigations. It also explores an approach to studies in areas of topics to include: investigative retrieval, its management and interpretation; all aspects of interviewing, statement assessment, validation and analysis, the detection of deception, and related matters of forensic hypnosis and lie detectors and false allegations.
- This can also help understand and estimate behavior in different social situations.
- Psychological and Personality profiles can be deduced from background information. Profiling can help estimate behaviors, habits, personal traits and special talents.

There are no traits that are all bad or all good.

Certain traits in certain situations would be extremely desirable and those same traits in a different situation could be extremely undesirable.

Investigative profiling is an ongoing, speculative process that must be evaluated and reevaluated, checked and double checked, so that no questionable stone is left unturned and no viable avenue is left unexplored. Profiling doesn't solve crimes or cases, investigators do.

INTERNET PROFILING: involves an investigative process to provide a client with the "Internet Footprint" of a subject. What have they done on-line? Where have they gone? How many web-pages? Posting habits, surfing habits, interests, background information, associates and much more.
